Queens Civics and residents and their supporters demand:

- 1. Remove the old noisy and polluting 727's from operating in high density urban areas like ours.
- 2. Legislate and enforce a curfew from 10pm to 7am
- 3. Role back fights per day to 1990 levels.
- 4. Aviation industry accountability to communities surrounding the airports.
- 5. Reduce toxic emissions linked to cancer, asthma, lung disease
- 6. Pres. Clinton to immediately refund the Office of Abatement and Control
- 7. Reduce Aircraft Noise, pass the [Member of Congress Nita] Lowey Quiet Communities Act.
- 8. Measure Air Pollution, by actively working for a Bubble Bill to make the airports responsible for their activities.
- 9. Enforce the High Density Rule
- 10. Plan for a long range intermodal transportation system with high speed train, so that air shuttles become an exception rather than a rule.
- 11. Disband the Borough President's Queens Aviation Advisory Council
