## QUEENS CIVICS WORKSHOP ON BSA, 3/24, 7:30 p.m.

The next Queens Civic Congress meeting, a workshop on the Board of Standards and Appeals, takes place Monday, March 24, 7:30 p.m. at the Union Plaza Nursing Home, 33-23 Union Street, Flushing (three blocks north of Northern Blvd.), announced QCC President Sean M. Walsh. "The workshop on Board of Standards procedures for civic associations offers a basic primer since developers and others turn to this forum to circumvent zoning restrictions meant to protect neighborhood itegrity and character," stated Mr. Walsh. "Sooner or later decisions by BSA affect almost every New Yorker. It includes whether an outsized building can be located on your block or whether a commercial use will be permitted in contravention of the prevailing zoning." The Queens Civic Congress represents 100 civic, community, condo, co-operative, homeowner and tenant organizations. Its membership represents almost every community in the borough.

Land use attorney Eric Palatnik, who has represented many clients before the BSA will discuss BSA rules and requirements and provide guidance to civic leaders on how to approach the agency on behalf of community groups, said Patricia Dolan, QCC Executive Vice President for Land Use and Planning, who arranged the workshop.

Since the 1989 City Charter proscribed the demise of the old Board of Estimate and transferred many zoning powers formerly exercised by that board of executives to the City Council, no formal appeals process, short of a judicial proceeding exists for civics and other community groups who find fault with a decision of the Board of Standards and Appeals, noted QCC Executive Vice President for Pubic and Legislative Affairs Corey Bearak. In other business, QCC members will hear reports on community facilities by Mr. Walsh and QCC Community Facilities Zoning Chair Tyler Cassell. The Queens Civic Congress and its members initiated a petition drive calling on "the Mayor, Members of the City Council, and Members of the City Planning Commission to remedy the problems plaguing our communities from the Community Facility provisions of the New York City Zoning Resolution." The Congress already circulated the petition in its newsletter, the Queens Civic Congressional, and through emails to its member-organizations. The Petition will soon be available on the Queens Civic Congress website for interested individuals to copy and circulate in their communities. Later this week the Congress will unveil an online petition drive as

well. The Congress efforts focuses on the need for city planners to remove the "Bulk Bonus" and mandate parking requirements for all such facilities in all "R" zones for all community facilities as part of a text change to the City's Zoning Resolution.
