Moreover in a column, I wrote a few years back, I outlined how investments in our cultural programs and institutions yield many more dollars back in economic development and tax revenues: "Studies have shown that a small investment by the city in culturals leads to higher income to restaurants, hotels, etc. from tourists who visit the museums and theaters; the city largely recoups the investment through higher sales and income taxes. Retaining those of our residents who patronize the arts remains important because these New Yorkers tend to be the better educated, higher income people who support our tax base."
